





5. Lovely 19th Century English Textile or Sewing Supply Label. A

really lovely 19th century label for an unknown product by an unknown company- but the size or gauge was seven and a half. By the look of the label and the note one suspects cloth, thread or some such product, and a date of around 1850-1860 or so. Label. 4"x2.5". Some soil and wear, two edge rips stabilized with backing paper. [44484] \$20

6. Mid 19th Century Waterbury Connecticut Sewing Hooks & Eyes Label.

A nicely designed label for the Waterbury Union Co.'s 'Superior Hooks and Eyes'. Probably 1850s or 1860s. Label. 5"x3.5". Mounted on card backing, some wear and light soil. [44488] \$35





7. **19th Century Wamsutta Textile Mills Label New Bedford.** A handsome label from the famous Wamsutta Mills in New Bedford, Massachusetts. The extensive smoke belching factory is shown in an aerial view, and the handsome lettering is filled in silver. Single sheet 7.75"x5.5". Minor soil, probably trimmed from a rectangle. 8. **1890s Semples Spool Cotton Lake Boat Scene Trade Card.** Ah, what is so rare as a day in May, out on the lake in a rowboat with your best girl and Semples Spool Cotton... Trade card. 2"x3.25". Some loss on the back. [44494] \$15






14. 1870s Cumberland Mills Swiss Blankets American Card.

Obviously these Swiss Blankets weren't actually made in Switzerland, they were made at the mill in, well, probably Cumberland. Perhaps they smelt faintly of Swiss chocolate or something. Card. 2.5"x3.5". Minor soil, light wear. [46246] \$35

15. 19th Century Blue & Gold American Eagle Label.

A handsome embossed label with the American eagle in gold on a blue ground. Such labels were often used for textiles, but there is no space for a yard/price to be written, so the use of this label remains uncertain. Label. About 3"x3.5". Some light wear and minor soil. [46837] \$40





16. 19th Century English Bishop's Lawn Black & Gold

Embossed Label. A very handsome and striking label. Such labels were often used for textiles, but there is no space for a yard/price to be written, so the use of this label remains uncertain. Label. About 3"x3". Some light wear and minor soil; creases, with small pinholes. [46838] \$50

17. 19th Century American Silver & Black Embossed Eagle


Label. A very handsome and striking label. Such labels were often used for textiles, but there is no space for a yard/price to be written, so the use of this label remains uncertain. At the base of the plinth there is some semi-legible lettering which seems to say "Wi(??)rry's Co. - Providence". Label. About 3.5"x4". Some light wear and minor soil, right edge unevenly cut. 18. **19th Century American or English Textile Label with Silver Deer.** A handsome textile label featuring a silver stag surrounded by floral work, as stags in the wild so often were. Label. 3.5"x4.5". Some minor soil and light wear, rubbing. [46840] \$35





Francois-Philibert's son, Philibert Vrau, took over in the 1850s and revitalized the brand which soared in popularity in the 1860s and 1870s. Philibert Vrau (1829-1905) was a philanthropist who founded a Catholic engineering school and donated a large portion of his income to social causes.. 3.75"x5.75", Minor soil. [43377] \$250

Label. An attractive 19th century gold foil cut-out textile label. Label. 8"x2.5". Minor soil, light wear. [44654] \$45







31. 1920s Calcutta Jardine Skinner Peacock Textile Label.








46. **1870s Fukushima Japan 'Kakeda Silk' Label.** In 1880 the Japan Weekly Mail complained- "Now it is well know, to all silk buyers, that the district from which true Kakeda silk comes is of small extent and quite incapable of producing more than a fractional part of the silk which is put on the market under its name. The quality of true Kakeda silk, being of exceptional excellence, has made for this class a name of renown; and it is no secret that reelers have attempted to profit from this by making nearly all Oshiu silks into so-called Kakeda, and thus bringing disrepute upon the original good stock". In the 1880s export from the district declined in favor of other regions with better quality-control methods. 5"x3.5". Minor soil; carefully mounted on a thin blue paper backing. [43378] \$175
