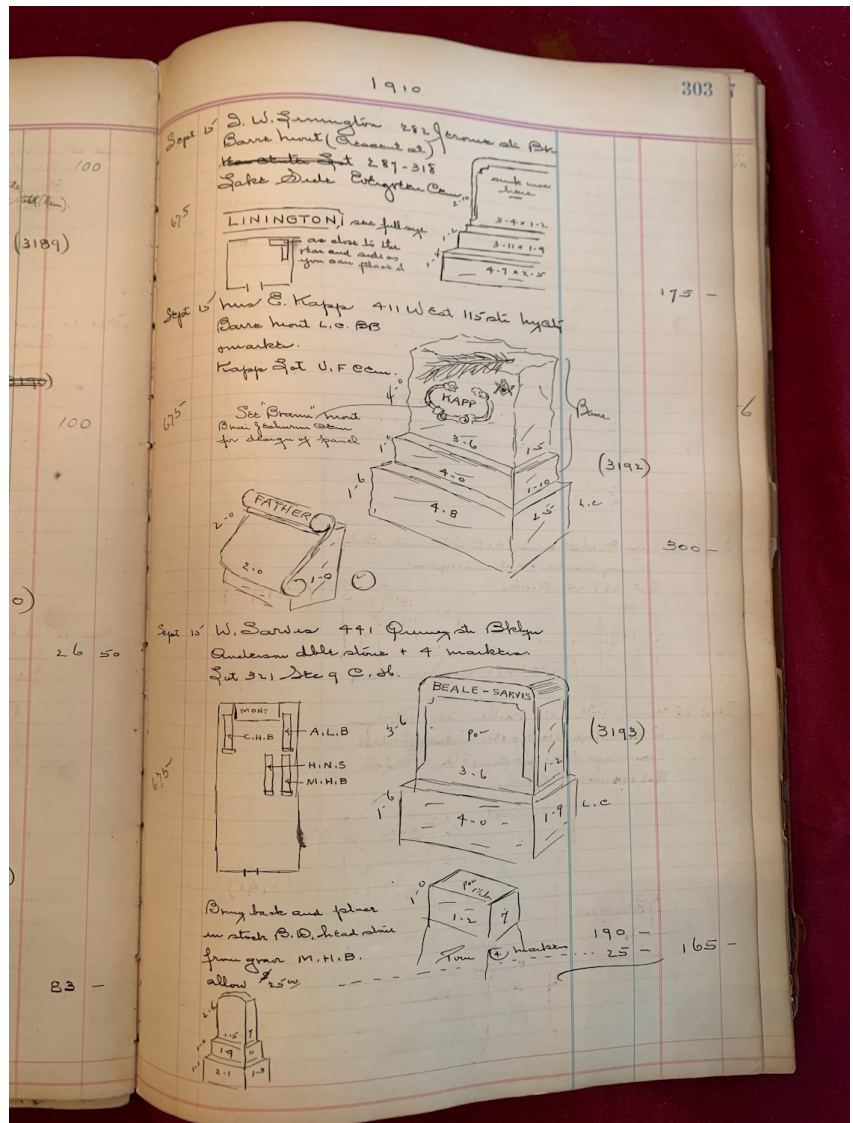

1] 1909-1911 Manuscript Ledger & Design Record for Brooklyn New York Area Cemetery Stone Mason.

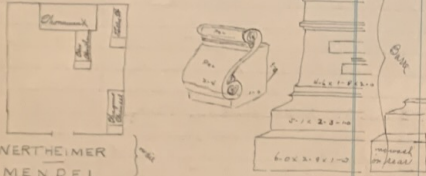
Dated from 1909-1911, this contains designs for headstones, monuments, and gravestones, and also documents work done to maintain existing structures in cemeteries. Among those listed are Mt. Zion Cemetery, Churchill Evergreen Cemetery, Greenwood Cemetery, Hewlett Cemetery, Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Rehobath Lodge Cemetery, Salem Fields Cemetery, Hungarian Cemetery, Lutheran Cemetery, Reuben Lodge, and Coldspring Memorial Cemetery, most of which still exist and are located in either Brooklyn or Flushing, New York.

Of special interest is the fact that it documents not only the designs of monuments, but includes the names and addresses of the customers, dimensions of the monument, descriptions of repairs and maintenance, and so on. There are also scattered entries for miscellaneous stonework such as columns for the Evergreen Stove Works and a stone gateway for the Magyne Rayngim Society.

2] 1916-1922 Manuscript Ledger for Brooklyn New York Area Cemetery Stone Mason.

A massive ledger documenting the Brooklyn New York-area work of a stone mason specializing in cemetery work. The entries (a half dozen or so per page) list the customer, the work done, and the price. Sample work includes “cut and seal catacomb”, “dark barre stone”, “burial of ashes”, “recut inscription”, “reset stones and beds”, and so on.



Cloth-covered leather covers, 12x16. About 75 un-numbered index pages, plus 800 numbered pages. Entries begin on page 1, and then pages 2-30 are blank (??) and entries begin again on page 31 and run through page 800. Leather ledger covers with a home-made cloth covering, the cloth is now totally shot and hanging off in sheets. The pages are mostly clean and good, the hinges are heavily tape-reinforced and thanks to that are pretty tight. A massive ledger- this thing has the approximate weight, and density, of a cinderblock. {57214} \$600
